✓ (2) I think that the model and swimming pool/Bath are second important because they both show Roman construction.

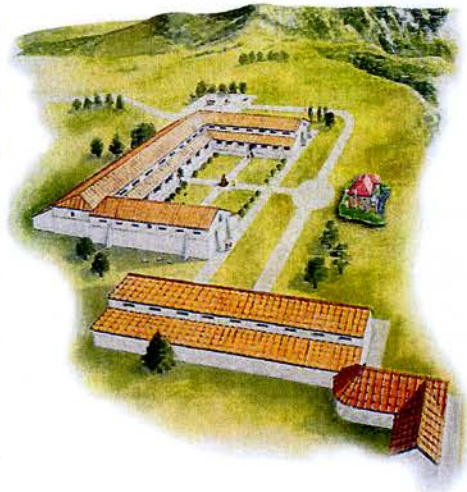
✓ (3) I think the mirror and samian pices are third most important because they are both pices of material *used in Roman Times.*

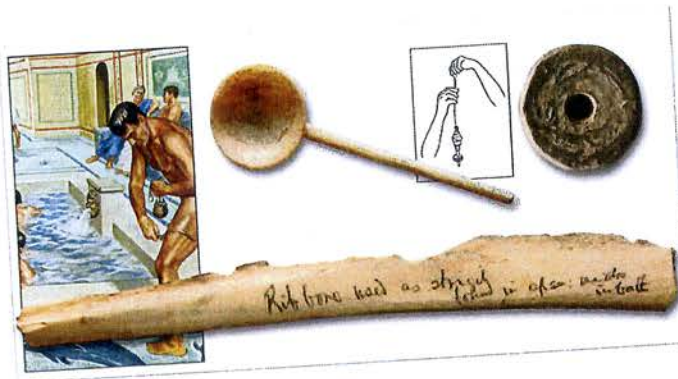
